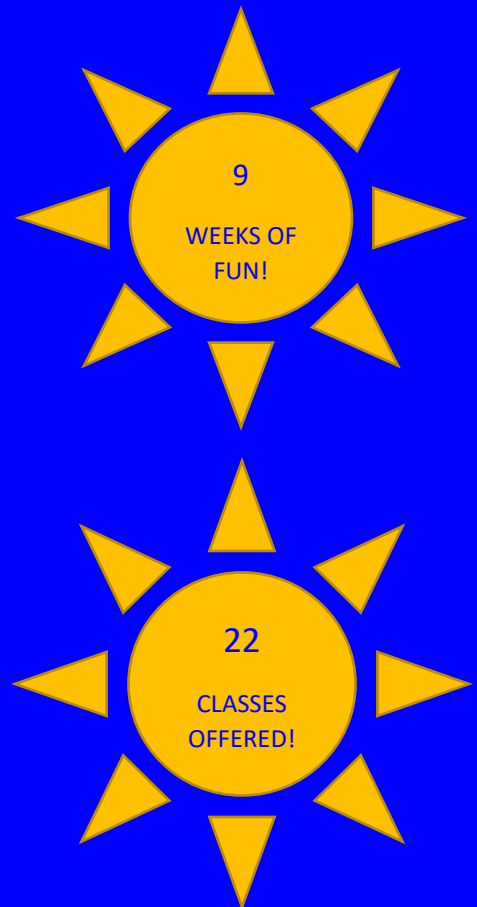

REGISTRATION:

Camp MSSA registration opens Friday, March 6, 2020. Each week of camp session registration will close on the Friday before the Monday start date.

FEES:

Camp sessions are \$315 per week. The week of June 29 to July 2 is a 4-day week (Monday to Thursday). Friday, July 3 camp is closed in observance of 4th of July holiday and the camp session fee is \$240. Payment is due in full at the time of registration.

Cancellations by family are non-refundable. If a camp is cancelled due to insufficient enrollment, families may transfer to another camp or a choose to receive a refund.

SCHEDULE:

Camp sessions are 9:00 am to 3:00 pm Monday to Friday. Before and after care is not available.

Arrival: 8:45 am to 9:00 am

Parents should follow the carpool line and drive around up front at the main building. Instructors will open car doors and escort your camper to the benches.

The following camp sessions: A Week at the Rec, Super Summer Basketball Camp, Soccer and Join the Summer Cast will have arrival and dismissal at the gym – building 2

Late arrival: Please park and escort your child inside the main building to check in at the front desk. If your child is going to be absent, please call the school office at (210) 492-3553.

Snacks: Snacks are provided daily for all campers. Children with special dietary needs should bring snacks from home.

Lunch: 11:45 am to 12:15 pm

Campers bring their lunch and water bottle from home. On Fridays, MSSA will provide cheese and pepperoni pizza from Rome's (gluten free pizza is an option).

Dismissal: 3:00 pm

All families will be given a car tag. Please place it on your passenger side front window to help instructors efficiently find your camper/campers at dismissal.

CAMP GEAR:

Each camper will receive one of each; CAMP MSSA t-shirt and bag. Campers are encouraged to wear their camp shirt on Fridays.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Lunch bag
 - Water bottle
 - Sunscreen (please apply before arriving, staff will assist with reapplication as necessary)
 - Change of clothes for children ages 3 to 6
- Children must wear closed toe shoes to camp. Some camp activities may involve water play or use materials that may stain clothing. Be sure to label lunch bag and water bottle with the camper's name.
